1. A copy of a transcript (non returnable) listing a grade for each course and a GPA for the year. (In addition, 9th-12th grade must include a cumulative GPA for the 9th-12th grade years.) Unless otherwise noted, GPA's will be on a 4 point scale.

2. A copy (returnable with a SASE) of national standardized test scores that meet chapter's criteria. (See FAQs for further information.)

3. A non-refundable check for \$10.00 (for each member) for chapter expenses made payable to Karyn Gleeson.

Note: If student does not meet GPA or testing criteria check will be returned.

4. An essay of one of the listed topics. Essay may be hand written or typed. Essay will be retained by chapter. Essay must be reflective of a sincere effort of the student. Essay will not be graded or evaluated for content or grammar. The purpose of the essay is to determine the interest level of the student.
